- Stay friendly and use respectful tone.
- Respect other opinions and ways of thinking.
- Discuss different opinions respectfully instead of attacking others.
- Insults, hurtful comments, and exclusion have no place here.
- Don't make anyone feel embarrassed or laugh at them.
- Do not spread rumors, lies or false information.
- If someone is excluded, insulted or bullied, get help immediately and offer support.

- In chat, the same rules apply for interaction as in a personal conversation
- remain friendly and respectful.
- A friendly greeting and a simple "please" or "thank you" can make a big difference.
- Think before sending messages and check information before sharing it.
- Avoid spam and unnecessary messages.

- Protect your privacy and never share personal information, such as your address, phone number, or passwords, online or in chats.
